"Power Peel" Now Offered at Aesthetic Surgery Center

The most powerful face peel available today has been introduced at The Aesthetic Surgery Center. The "UltraPeel" is the next generation in skin exfoliation systems first made popular by the glycolic acid peel.

"The UltraPeel is a microdermabrasion in which aluminum crystals are sprayed onto the skin, sanded, and vacuumed to remove imperfections and enhance the natural vitality and firmness of the skin," said Richard W. Maloney, M.D., Medical Director. "Results are apparent from the very first treatment."

Power peel skin treatments such as the UltraPeel have been available in Europe for about 10 years, but were just recently approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for use in this country.

"The UltraPeel is about three times more powerful than traditional face peels using glycolic acid," Dr. Maloney said.

"Most patients notice an immediate improvement in the skin's appearance," he said. "Age spots and fine lines are diminished and many patients report that their complexion feels softer, smoother, and younger looking."

Dr. Maloney cautioned that the UltraPeel is not a substitute for laser resurfacing, which is the more aggressive surgical procedure to eliminate lines, wrinkles, acne scarring and age spots.

"This is a complement to cosmetic surgery. It can be done before laser surgery to prepare the skin or post surgically to maintain and preserve the rejuvenation of the skin," he emphasized.

The treatment requires no anesthesia and is performed by the nursing staff in about 30 to 60 minutes. Most people experience no discomfort at all and return to work or their daily activities the same day.


Welcome to *Renaissance Review*, our new newsletter to keep patients and friends aware of the latest advances in facial plastic surgery and skin care.

New Hair Removal Laser Available at Aesthetic Surgery Center

Imagine no more painful waxing, plucking, shaving or electrolysis.

Now your unwanted hair can effectively be removed from the face, lip, chin, neck, underarms, bikini line, chest, back, legs and other areas using the latest generation of diode laser systems.



The most efficient, innovative, and advanced diode laser system is the LightSheer Laser, which is now available at The Aesthetic Surgery Center.

The LightSheer Laser, which has been approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), uses the light beam from the laser to target the pigment in the hair follicle beneath the skin surface. When the laser light is absorbed by the pigment in the hair follicle and hair shaft, the hair growth center is damaged.

"This results in either complete destruction of the hair, or severe restriction of regrowth. Those hair follicles that are in the active growth phase are the best targets for absorbing the laser light and it is these hairs that are preferentially damaged and destroyed," said Aesthetic Surgery Center Medical Director Richard W. Maloney, M.D., F.A.C.S.

The skin is cooled during treatment so that the laser causes little or no discomfort. Anesthesia normally isn't required for the procedure, which is performed by a nurse or aesthetician. New hair removal patients will receive a 30-minute consultation with Dr. Maloney before the first treatment.

Usually, a minimum of three treatments is necessary to achieve optimum results. Sessions are separated by an average of six to eight weeks.

The new "UltraPeel" is the most powerful of the peels. These "lunch hour" peels generally are performed in less than one hour and the patient is immediately able to resume normal activities.
- SEVERE SUN DAMAGE needs to be treated surgically with laser facial resurfacing, the newest weapon in the war on sun damage and wrinkling. In 1996, The Aesthetic Surgery Center was among the first in the southeastern United States to offer the Erbium-YAG Laser skin resurfacing. The Erbium Laser provides a lighter application of laser energy. The benefit to the patient is smoother skin, more rapid healing, and faster return to normal activities. For individuals with acne scarring, Erbium combined with CO2 lasers provide dramatic and enhanced results.

And to protect the skin on an ongoing basis, Dr. Maloney says to always use broad spectrum sunscreen, but be sure it protects against both UVA and UVB rays with an SPF factor of at least 15.

UV Reflectance System Reveals Sun Damage

How do you know when the cumulative effect of sun damage to the skin is too much?

Dr. Maloney recommends that his patients have their photo taken on the UV Reflectance System, which is available for free in his office. Using ultraviolet light, the camera shows sun damage that isn't visible to the naked eye.
